In the spirit of fostering cross-border cooperation in the international STS research community and in line with the goal of the Trieste European Science Open Forum (ESOF) 2020 of which STS Italia conference is an official accompanying event, a special, open track is organized to bring together scholars from Central and Eastern European countries to discuss the state of art in Science and Technology Studies (STS) research of Post-Socialist Europe.

Scholars based in public and private research institutions and universities of Central and Eastern Europe are invited to share their current and recent research projects in STS, in order to highlight how this research field has been developing. The track invites theoretical, empirical and methodological contributions to explore the diverse streams of this development.

Finally, contributions and reflections on the challenges and prospects of STS in CEECs are welcome, with a particular attention to international and national network building and to the interaction of STS with policy worlds.
